

## INMED ASM 2018 February 7<sup>th</sup>-9<sup>th</sup> University College Cork

### Guidelines for Abstract Submission

INMED has issued a call for abstract submissions for its forthcoming ASM in Dublin from February 7<sup>th</sup>-9<sup>th</sup> 2018. The title of this year's meeting is: *Clinical Supervision: What works, how and why?*

Submissions should be for **Oral presentation** or **ePoster presentation** and should be submitted in the following format:

1. In Microsoft Word format
2. In no more than 250 words (which will be enforced)
3. In the following abstract structure:
  - a. Rationale  
What is the purpose of the research or educational development and what problem does it address?
  - b. Methods
  - c. Findings  
What were the research outcomes; evaluative findings?\*
  - d. Discussion/conclusion

\*The abstract adjudication panel will consider research in progress or development projects where outcomes are not yet available to report.

**The deadline for submission is midnight on Friday 10<sup>th</sup> November 2017.**

Every effort will be made to accommodate preferred methods of presentation. However if the number of applications exceeds the number of presentation slots available, it may be necessary to offer a poster presentation option to some who preferred an oral presentation.
